SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSE, ELIGIBILITY and REQUIREMENTS for 2007

Eligibility -

- 👤 Children or Grandchildren of a Marine Corps League or MCL Auxiliary member *in good standing*.

Definitions -

New Applicant - the applicant has never been awarded a scholarship from the Department of Connecticut Marine Corps League.

Renewal Applicant - the applicant is a prior recipient of a scholarship from the Department of Connecticut Marine Corps League.

APPLICATION ATTACHMENTS AND TIMELINE:

1. The application must be postmarked no later than **10 June 2007**.
2. The applicant must provide proof of enrollment.
3. The applicant must attach a transcript of her/his grades
4. The applicant *may* attach a résumé.
